What is UCAS?



UCAS, the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service

Their services support young people making post-18 choices, by providing information, advice, and guidance to inspire and facilitate educational progression to university, college, or a degree apprenticeship.



Clearing opens for some students only

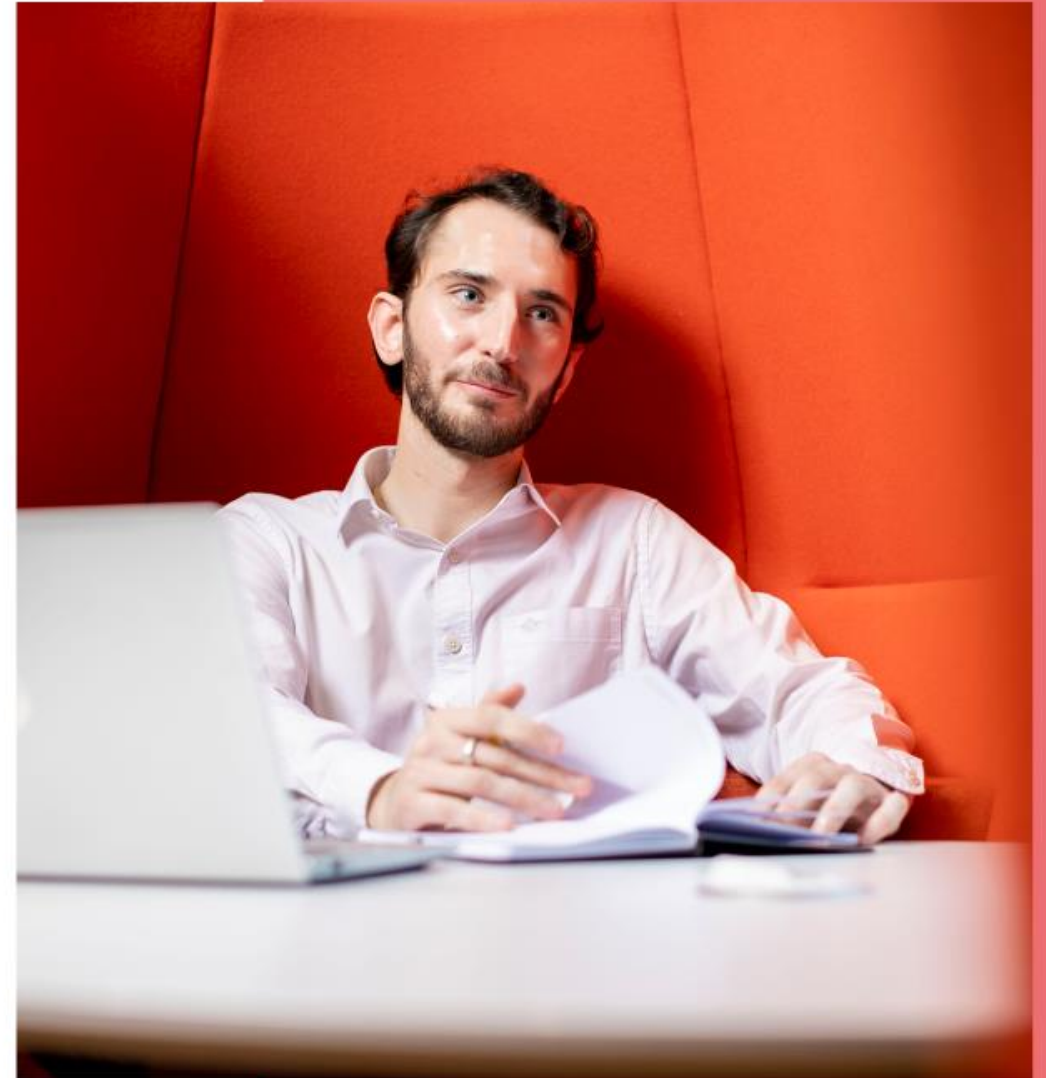
From 5 July – 18 October, you can apply for a course using Clearing if you're not already holding an offer from a university or college, and the course still has places.

You can use Clearing if:

you're applying after 30 June

you didn't receive any offers (or none you wanted to accept)

you've [declined your firm place](#) using the 'decline my place' button in your application



15 Aug 2024

A Level Results Day (main part of Clearing)

If you didn't meet the conditions of your offers (firm or insurance choice) on results day you will automatically be entered into clearing.

Don't panic, lots of students secure places through clearing every year. You can see what courses are available on the UCAS clearing course search page or on the university websites directly. You will need to be prepared to approach universities yourself to see if they may be able to offer you a place on the course you are interested in.

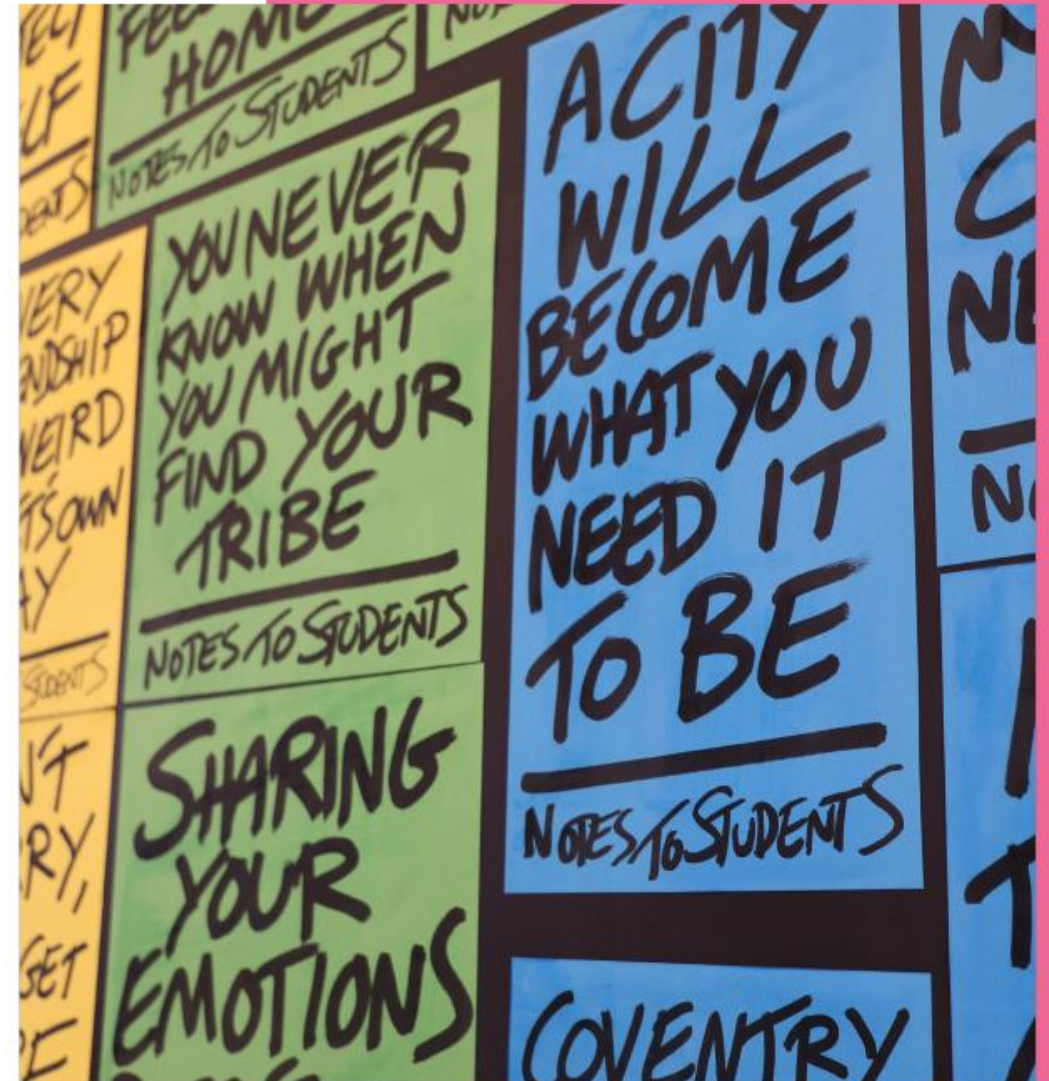
