

## Our Student Achievements

At The Latimer Arts College, we believe in encouraging students to aspire for the highest possible academic achievement. We believe in the value of examinations as the 'passport' for accessing higher education or training and a wider choice of careers.

### GCSE and Level 2 Performance Measures

Schools are now judged on the following measures:

**Student Progress (Progress 8):** the average progress made by students in 8 subjects, with Maths and English progress having a double weighting.

**Student Attainment (Attainment 8):** the best grades students achieve in 8 subjects.

### GCSE and Level 2 Performance

In 2017 students at The Latimer Arts College made expected progress, in line with the national progress of similar students. Our progress score increased by +0.2 from the previous year (2016).

In 2017 the Attainment 8 score for students at The Latimer Arts College was 45.4 points. This was above the national average.

In 2018 the results for both Progress 8 and Attainment 8 further improved.

In 2018 the initial indications are that students at The Latimer Arts College will have made above average progress. It is anticipated that our progress score will have increased by +0.3 from the previous year.

This will provisionally place the College's progress measures in approximately the top 30% of schools nationally.

In 2018 the provisional Attainment 8 score for students at The Latimer Arts College is 46.7 points, an increase on last year and would place us above the national average.

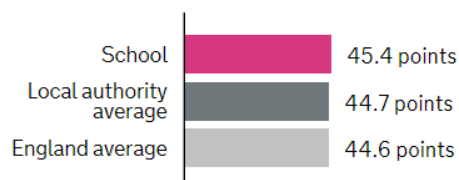
#### 2017 School score:
