| Stage | Description |
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| Emerging | A student in this band will be able to make simple comments about a text. They will be able to make some reference to textual details and ideas. They will show awareness of the writer making choices and will make some reference to subject terminology. |
| Developing | A student in this band will be able to make a range of supported comments relevant to the text and task by referencing relevant textual details. The student will be also show an understanding of the writer making deliberate choices with some reference to subject terminology. The student will begin to identify features of language and structure with some explanation of the effect on the reader. |
| Secure | A student in this band will be able to provide a clearly explained and supported response to task and text. The student will use textual references to support a range of relevant ideas. They will make relevant comments on the writer's methods with relevant use of subject terminology. The student will also demonstrate some understanding of implicit ideas/perspectives within the text by identifying language and structural features and clearly explaining the effect on the reader. |
| Excellence | A student in this band will be able to respond to a text/task with thoughtful and developed consideration. Students will select a range of apt textual references to support their ideas. They will be able to provide an examination of the writer's methods with accurate subject terminology. The student will be able to explore implicit meanings of the writer's craft (language and structure) and will begin to evaluate the effect on different readers. |
