Breaking News: We Are Flying High with Results August 2018!

We are delighted to be able to share with you some fantastic news about our GCSE Results in August 2018, following the recent release of provisional national data by the Department for Education.

Our Progress 8 Score is provisionally +0.24 and this indicates that our students' progress was above average and places us approximately in the top 30% of schools nationally. This is a significant increase of +0.3 from the previous year.

Well done to our very hard working and committed Class of 2018. Of course, our ambition is to improve even more this year! Year 11, are you up to the challenge?

ROK (Retention of Knowledge) Strategies
