

Year 8 **Promotion and Mechanism** 16 Lessons Aims: Students taught in the structure of the 'Design Process' as used in KS4. Students are to explore this process in order to develop a 'promotional display' similar to cinema 'standees'. This allows them to work with the basic structure for a POS display they may expect to come across at KS4. They are also introduced to a variety of mechanisms and select one for use on their display. Links to KS4: The set tasks are assessed with a focus upon the student's ability to make 3 dimensional objects from a 2d 'net'. It aids their ability to see things in the 3 dimensional space in their mind. Alongside this, students are introduced to the idea of designing within 'constraints' that would be expected at KS4. They will also be introduced to linkage mechanisms which directly relate to Graphics, Product Design and RM subjects.
