Our Student Achievement



At The Latimer Arts College, we believe in encouraging students to aspire for the highest possible academic achievement. We believe in the value of examinations as the 'passport' for accessing higher education or training and a wider choice of careers.

GCSE and Level 2 Performance Measures

Schools are now judged on the following measures:

Student Progress (Progress 8): the average progress made by students in 8 subjects, with Maths and English progress having a double weighting. This is reported as a number which compares the progress made by students at the school, to the national progress made by similar students. A score above 0 means students at the school are making better progress than the national average.

Student Attainment (Attainment 8): the best grades students achieve in 8 subjects. This is reported as a number, which adds the scores of the best 8 grades achieved by each student. This is compared to the score achieved by all students nationally, and takes no account of their starting points from Key Stage 2.

GCSE and Level 2 Performance (based on provisional results)

In 2023 students at The Latimer Arts College made **above** expected progress, with our results putting us in the top 25% of schools. Our progress score was **+0.4**.

In 2023 the Attainment 8 score for students at The Latimer Arts College was 48.0 points. This was above the national average.

In 2023 48% of our students achieved at least a grade 5 in both English and Maths and 68% achieved at least a grade 4 in both English and Maths.



In 2022, although data was difficult to compare due to the pandemic, the school achieved a progress score of +0.2. Prior to the pandemic the school achieved a progress score of +0.24 in 2019 and 2018. These scores would put the school in the top 25% of schools nationally for progress.

NB. Data for 2023 is **provisional**, subject to the official publication of national results (October 2023).

A Level and BTEC Level 3 Performance

In 2023 our students achieved the best ever A Level results (*excluding 2020 and 2021 where examinations did not take place due to Covid*).

20% of all grades were A*/A with 57% being grade A*-B.

94% of all BTEC level 3 grades were Distinction* or a Distinction.

86% of all students were successful in their first choice University offer (compared to 79% nationally).
