Redrock Learning

Bedrock Vocabulary: Years 7-9

Language and literacy are the bedrock of all learning. Students in Years 7-9 have a dedicated library lesson each fortnight where, alongside Accelerated Reader, they access an online vocabulary curriculum: <u>Bedrock</u>.

Bedrock was created by teachers and encompasses <u>Tier 2</u> vocabulary, to equip students with the knowledge needed to improve their educational outcomes.

Our students work through a series of lessons, assigned by Bedrock after a short test to make sure their learning is suited to their ability. Topics consist of a range of original fiction and non-fiction texts, all of which are human narrated so students are provided with headphones. Each fortnight, students are expected to complete a further 20 minutes (minimum) on Bedrock as part of their KS3 homework.

Regular use of Bedrock will make students' written and spoken language richer, at the same time as building their confidence to tackle challenging texts.
