An Invitation to The Latimer Arts College Open Evening 2023

As you are aware, you are entering a time when you have to make some very important decisions about secondary school choices. In order to support you with this, we are delighted to extend an invitation for you to visit The Latimer Arts College's Open Evening on **Thursday 5 October 2023** from **5.30pm-8.00pm**. Students, staff and governors are proud of our success and we would love you to come and visit us so that we can show you why.

Showcasing Our Success

As part of the evening, the Principal will deliver a formal presentation in our Masque theatre. This gives an overview of life at Latimer, our student achievements and future developments. The first presentation will start at 5.30pm and will be repeated every 30 minutes until 7pm.

This event is always extremely popular so we do ask that you minimise the number of visitors to site and where possible make alternative arrangements for young siblings. A ticketing system for the presentation slot will operate on the evening in order to minimise waiting times and we ask you to visit the 'Welcome Marquee' on arrival to collect your tickets. This will be clearly signposted for you. We thank you for your patience and understanding if there is a need to wait for the next presentation.

In line with our core purpose ***'Unlocking Potential – Inspiring Excellence'***, the evening's theme is ***'Be a star: Illuminate the world with your brilliance!'*** and you and your child are invited to visit all of our learning areas and participate in the activities that are taking place. These will give you a flavour of how we inspire our students to ***'be the best that they can be'***. Our student ambassadors will be on hand to escort you to any areas that you would like to see. We recommend that your child wears trainers on the evening so that they can participate in the sporting activities. This can be done before or after the presentation and you should allow at least an hour to see all the areas.

Planning Your Visit

Parking is always at a premium and although there is on-site parking, we do ask that, if you are able to, you visit us on foot. We will have car park marshalls on duty to support with finding you a parking space as quickly as possible but the evening will be busy and we do ask for your patience with this. In order to support our local community on this evening, please do park responsibly.

Refreshments will be served by our catering providers, abm Catering Solutions, in our canteen throughout the evening.

Admissions September 2024

Our Admissions Team will be available in our Library to answer any questions that you have about the admissions process, including the application procedures for our 20 Arts College places.

Applications for an Arts College place should be made to the College on the relevant application form, which can be downloaded from our website or collected on the evening, as well as via the North Northamptonshire Council (NNC) Admission process. The deadline for submitting an Arts Application to the College is **9.00 am on Monday 9 October 2023**, with the selection process to be held through informal Arts Workshops. Successful applicants will be invited to attend workshops during the week commencing **Monday 16 October 2023**.

Parents and carers will be notified if their child fulfils the criteria for an Arts place by **Friday 20 October 2023**. Please note, this will **not** be confirmation that a place has been offered at The Latimer Arts College, as only the NNC Admission Team can allocate school places and they will notify parents and carers of this in March 2024. However, it will give you a strong indication as to whether your child meets our criteria.

'Open Days': Tuesday 10th, Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th October

In order to help make your decision, you may wish to experience learning during a normal day, if so you are welcome to join one of our tours on our 'Open Days' at either **9.40am, 11:00am or 1:10pm**.
