1. Non-uniform refers to clothing and shoes only.

4. Coloured hair spray and face paints are not appropriate.
5. Latimer PE kit should be brought on the day as usual.
6. For health and safety reasons, if your son or daughter is doing work in the Design Workshop or Science areas, then school shoes must be worn, not trainers.

If students wish to wear non-uniform on this day, they should bring £1 and hand it to their form tutor during form time on 15<sup>th</sup> March.
