This is the main entrance to the college on Castle way. You could also access college via the Masque gate entrance to the rear of the college or alternatively, the Grosvenor Way entrance, with a turning circle for car drop off and pick up.

Our New Science Learning Centre



Our brand new state of the art Science learning centre opened in September 2020.

It is a fantastic space offering you the opportunity to experience a range of activities, experiments and equipment.

The building has two floors of Science laboratories/classrooms.

We are excited for you to use it in September 2021.



Main Reception & Student Services Reception

We have two reception areas. One at the front of the college for visitors and one in the main building for our students.

As a student, the Student Services Reception is your first port of call if you feel unwell, have an injury or have any general questions.

If you do need to sign out for any medical appointments, you would go to Student Services to do this and then wait to be collected in the main reception.



The New Sports Learning Centre

We have a brand new state of the art Sports Learning Centre which opened in 2020.

You get changed and leave your PE bag and uniform on the benches or pegs. The teachers will collect your valuables and lock these away.

Don't forget to bring in suitable footwear for our new 4G pitch; this is another fantastic facility at our college which is located next to the Sports Learning Centre.



The Quad Area

The Quad is an open space between the main building and the Art & Design Learning Centre where you can hang out at break and lunchtime. There are picnic benches scattered around for you to use.

College events take place here, such as an annual Remembrance Day or our Latimer Arts Week.

Art & Design Technology Learning Centre



This door takes you through to our Art & Design Technology Learning Centre.

There are DT workshops, textiles rooms and specialist equipment to enhance your learning experience!

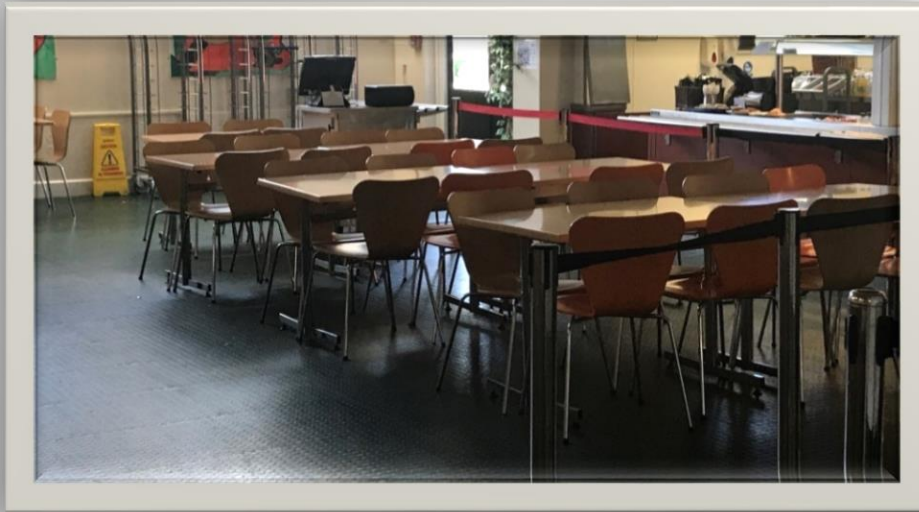
Humanities & MFL Learning Centre (Main building)



This door leads into the main building, including the Humanities (History, Geography and Religious Studies) classrooms and Modern Foreign Languages. Picasso's catering service is also through here.

Catering Facilities - Picasso's

- Picasso's is the main food service, serving hot and cold food (chips are served on a Friday!)
- You join a queue outside the canteen before entering which is supervised by staff.
- If you bring your own food, you can enter and eat it in here or another allocated place. **Please do not bring in any nut based foods.**



There are lots of spaces around the site for you to go to eat if you bring in your own packed lunch.

English Learning Centre and Learning Resource Centre



This door leads into our English learning centre where lessons involving Shakespeare, poetry and creative writing await!



The Learning Resources Centre (LRC) is just inside the ground floor of the main Humanities/MFL Learning Centre.

You can use the LRC as a quiet place at breaktime and lunchtime or to print homework. There are also iPads that you might get to use in lessons.

You can choose from so many books in the LRC. You will choose an Accelerated Reader book to read in English lessons and during DEAR (Drop Everything and Read) time.

Make sure you have a book in your bag at all times as part of your Ready to Learn checklist.

The Masque - Performing Arts Learning Centre



So many exciting Performing Arts lessons go on in the Masque. You will need to get changed for your Dance lessons and the Dance changing rooms are to the left of the Masque as you go in the front doors. The Drama studio is on the right hand side of the building. Our Music rooms are upstairs in this building.



Tutor Time and Assembly

You will meet your form group and form tutor for 25 minutes every day.

Each day of the week, you will explore a variety of activities such as Numeracy Ninja challenges, Literacy word wheels and you will develop your Leadership, Organisation, Resilience and Initiative and Communication skills with our LORIC programme of activities.

One day will be Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) based activities. One day will be a current affairs team quiz and one day you will have an assembly.

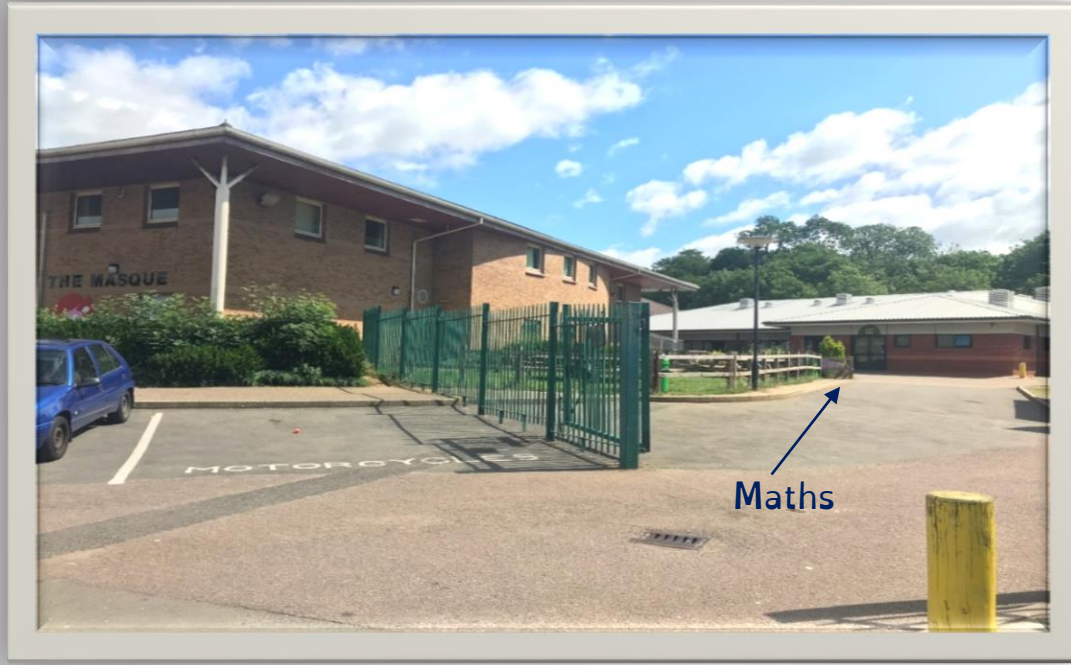
Assemblies are held in the Masque. You line up in your form group and the seating is set up so you are nice and comfortable.

Maths Learning Centre - leading to our Sixth Form Centre



As you walk towards the Masque, you will see this alternative route through to the Maths block.

Behind the Maths block is the Sixth Form Centre.

If you have Dance, you may be asked to use the entrance at the back of the Masque - this is the way you get to that as well.

Design Technology Workshops & DT Food Room



There are many rooms in the DT Learning Centre that have specialist equipment for each of the subjects you may be studying such as Resistant Materials, DT Food, Art, DT Graphics and DT Textiles. Some of the doors are outside of the Learning Centre. The DT Food room is a building on its own (above). It is next to the Maths Learning Centre.
