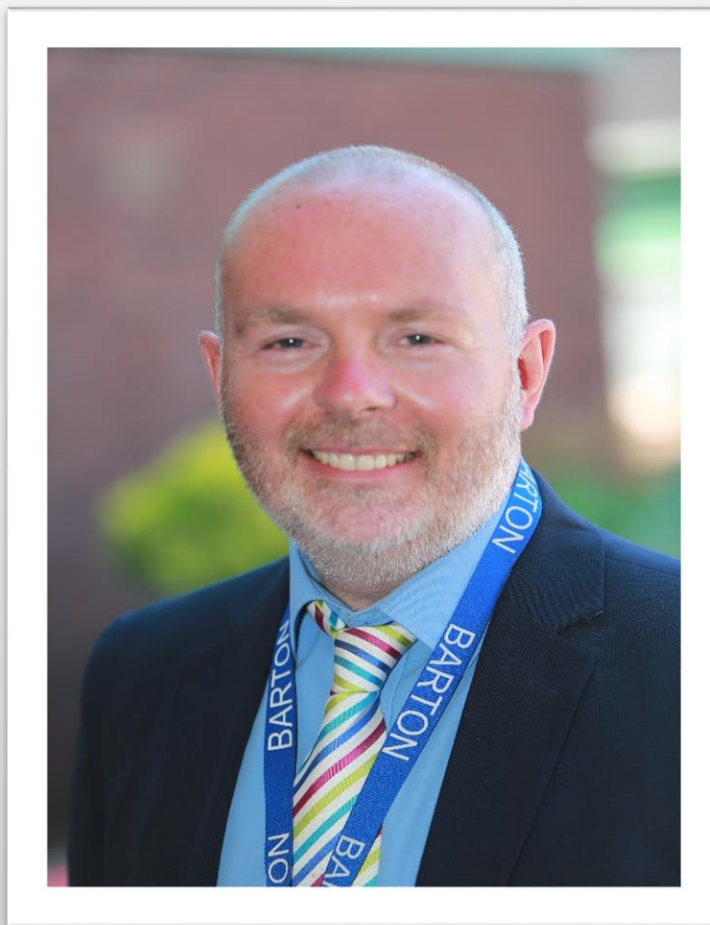

# Our Latimer Uniform

- All students must have a Latimer blazer and Latimer tie direct from our uniform supplier: **Karlsports. PE and Dance** uniform is also required as outlined in the information pack
- All students must avoid incorrect uniform items such as skinny or cropped trousers, leggings or shirts that cannot be used with a tie or be tucked into school trousers or a skirt
- All students must avoid incorrect school shoes (no black pumps, trainers or boots)
- All students must avoid additional piercings, unnatural hair colour, jewellery and acrylic nails
- Our uniform policy is non-negotiable



# Attendance and Punctuality

- Every day counts and every lesson counts – Our expectation is at least 96% attendance, each year
- Direct link with attendance and achievement
- Avoid holidays during term time
- Avoid medical appointments during the day
- Attendance will be monitored and rewarded





# Behaviour for learning

- Every child has the right to learn
- Systems and sanctions are in place for behaviour that challenges and disrupts learning – See pages 11-13
- Behaviour for Learning detentions
- Students can gain positive epraise points
- Students can receive subject postcards or positive emails or a phone call for demonstrating **positive** behaviour for learning





# Equipment- Being organised

- Students should have a suitable school bag for learning
- Students must be ready to learn with equipment and spares!
- Literacy - Students must have a regular reading book for **Drop Everything and Read**. We also operate an Accelerated Reader Scheme in Year 7
- Students should have Black ink pens and red pens for peer marking and assessment
- Students will need a calculator for Maths- **Casio FX83**
