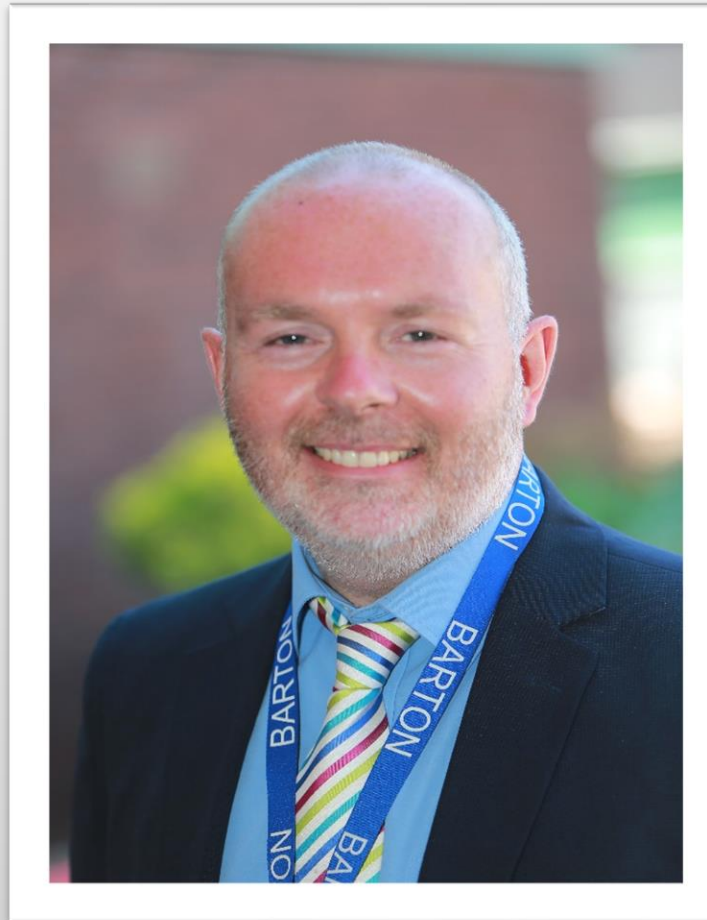

Our Latimer Uniform – worn with pride

- All learners must have a Latimer blazer direct from our uniform supplier: **Karlsports**. PE and Dance uniform is also required as outlined in the information pack. **A Latimer house tie will be provided.**
- All learners must avoid incorrect uniform items such as skinny or cropped trousers, leggings or shirts that cannot be used with a tie or be tucked into school trousers or a skirt
