#### Breaking News: Reward System Relaunch

At the Latimer Arts College, we pride ourselves on our culture of recognition and reward and love the opportunity to celebrate our students' successes. This is epitomised by our Pride of Latimer Awards Evening, for which invitations will soon be sent out.

We are also continually looking at ways in which we can improve current systems and we are delighted to be able to inform you that we will be launching E-Praise, a new online reward system, from September.

The current VIVO system will run until the end of the academic year. Students that have remaining VIVO points will have the opportunity to spend them on our bumper end of year raffle in July, which will have more prizes than ever before. More details about all of this will be shared with students soon.

### Learning and Progress

#### Ensuring success through outstanding attendance

We must take this opportunity to remind parents and carers that, under DfE rules, head teachers **may not grant** any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Parents and carers may be given a fixed term penalty for taking their child on holiday during term time without consent from the College. These penalties can range from between £60 and £120 and are payable within 28 days. Each parent and carer may be fined for each individual child. Penalties are imposed by Northamptonshire County Council (NCC) and the monies collected do **not** come to the College.

Unauthorised holidays which result in absences of 10 school sessions (the equivalent of 5 days) or more may be referred for fixed term penalties.

#### And why would you want your child to miss all of this?

We have a fantastic range of learning experiences and opportunities this term:

- Year 10 and Year 12 Exams: For Year 10, exams will run from Thursday 20 June until Friday 28 June. Students will not be in normal lessons from Monday 24 June until Friday 28 June and will be provided with sessions in College to help them prepare for their exams. For Year 12, exams will mainly run from Thursday 20 June until Friday 28 June (with some small changes for students who study Geography due to their field trip).
- Sixth Form UCAS Exhibition: On Friday 21 June, Year 12 students will be taken to the University of Bedfordshire, where they will have an opportunity to liaise with visiting exhibitors including UCAS experts, university and college representatives, and industry professionals. They will also have the opportunity to look around the university campus and ask those burning questions that Google just can't answer.
- Year 11 Celebration Day: On Friday 21 June, Year 11 will have their Celebration Assembly and Prom.
- Year 13 Celebration Day: On Friday 28 June, Year 13 will have their Celebration Assembly, as they leave The Latimer Arts College to move on to pastures new.
- Sixth Form Induction Week: For those Year 11 students who plan to join us in September, attending these sessions on Tuesday 2 July and Wednesday 3 July is compulsory.
- Year 12 Work Experience: Running from Monday 1 July to Friday 5 July, as part of our Raising Aspirations programme, our Year 12 students will undertake a week of work experience designed to support them to develop their employability skills.

- **Pride of Latimer Awards**: on Thursday 4 July at The Lighthouse Theatre.
- Enrichment Events: Year 8 will be visiting the Black Country Museum, Year 9 Art and Design students are off to the Victoria and Albert Museum and Year 10 will have the privilege of visiting the Wimbledon Tournament!

#### Safe Cycling: we need your parent voice!

You may be aware that one of our students was recently involved in a serious accident whilst cycling to school. Thankfully, although sustaining injuries that saw him hospitalised, the student concerned is expected to make a full recovery. The one saving grace is that he was wearing a cycling helmet, otherwise his condition could have been more serious!

Whilst we have done all that we can to get this message across to our students, many still think they are invincible and have the 'it will never happen to me' attitude. Sadly, it can and it might!

Therefore, we need parental support:

- Your child must have and wear a cycle helmet
- Bikes must be roadworthy, with lights and students need a lock
- We need you to insist to your child that they cycle responsibly

Patrols will be going out in the local area over the next few weeks and any student found to be riding unsafely will not be permitted to bring a bike to College in the future.
