When your child joined The Latimer Arts College, you may remember us saying that time would fly and it would not be long before preparations for GCSE examinations, and the celebrations that follow, would come around. Well, here we are!

Now, in the final terms of Year 11, many students have already taken BTEC examinations and there are **less than 120 days** until the first GCSE exam!

We are proud of the success that our **‘Ace Your Exams’** programme has delivered in the past and we have developed it to support both our students and their parents and carers to be examination ready and we would like to take this opportunity to outline this to you as the countdown commences.

Preparation for GCSE Exams

GCSE Trial Examinations Season 1: In November, students will be taking part in this programme to give them an early experience of what a GCSE paper looks like and how it feels to sit exams under examination conditions.

Students will receive their individual timetables soon. ***Please be aware that during the time period of the exams, normal school lesson time for Year 11 will be suspended to accommodate students sitting exams. Full details to follow.***

Study Support

Revision Guides: As a gift from the College, students have been issued with a set of revision guides for core subjects they study (subject to availability). Their revision programme should be a year-long process, rather than a last minute rush and we ask you to support us by getting them started sooner rather than later.

If you do not take our word for it, take the word of our departing Year 11s who said if they had one piece of advice for our next cohort of GCSE students, it would be **START REVISION EARLY!**

There is absolutely no doubt that experience shows us that success comes to those who work hard both in College and at home. It is vital that students complete additional learning outside of the classroom. You cannot assume that your child will do this for themselves and parents and carers must take an active role in insisting that this happens.

Tassomai makes learning and revising for GCSE Science effective and straightforward. Students can see the topics they need to work through, how they are getting on, and they can see what they should do next. Tassomai organises a daily routine, prioritising each topic and subject based on progress so far. Simply log in regularly and complete the assignments at the top of the list. To support students with accessing these apps, they will be trusted with ***access to the College's Wi-Fi system so that they can use their devices in lessons and form times to enhance their revision.***

Going forward for the year ahead!

Year 11 Term 1 and 2

1:1 Future Pathways Meeting: Students will have a 1:1 meeting with a Senior Leader or an Achievement Leader to discuss their future plans, identify key action points that need to be addressed and to identify if they need any further individual support at this time.

Sixth Form Pathways Evening: We invite students and parents and carers to join us on **4 November 2020** for the evening to explore options for post-16 study at The Latimer Arts College.

Tutor Time Revision Workshops: Students will be supported with their revision programme during tutor time, when they will take part in revision planning workshops in the lead up to trial examinations. They are also organised in their English and Maths sets to access additional tuition in these core subjects.

GCSE Trial Examination Results Day: This will be held on students' return to school in January and mirrors the actual results day that will take place in August 2021. Based on their mock examinations and current progress, students will be given their results in every subject. This will give an indication of how much distance they need to travel by the summer!

GCSE Trial Examination Season 2: This is planned to run in March when students will take trial examinations in all subjects. It is so important that they approach these examinations with the right attitude. It is an opportunity for students to have already prepared a substantial amount of revision notes and it will give them a benchmark for what they are secure in and what they need to focus on as a priority.

Easter Revision: A programme of revision sessions for individual subjects will take place during the Easter holidays in 2021 (subject to the national situation) and students will be invited to attend relevant sessions.

Alternative Timetable: Through a combination of revision sessions, masterclasses and home study, this programme will support students in their final run up to exams.

GCSE Summer Examination Season: We are awaiting government guidelines on when these will start next year. Some practical examinations will have taken place before this and all BTEC qualifications will have been completed.
