What are they?

We are arranging for you to do some CAT testing (cognitive ability).

These are **online** Tests which you **CANNOT prepare for**.

You do **not need to worry** about these, they are there to help us understand how you learn.

You will not get any results back or test scores shared, they are for us to use.

You will do 3 tests and a reading test (4 tests in 4 different lessons).

Some questions are all about WORDS – in this example you are given 3 WORDS. Pick the word which means the same as the first 3 words.

The answer is D as these first 3 words all mean the same as being uncertain.

blue \rightarrow colour: socks \rightarrow

A clothing

B feet

C shoes

D pair

E wear

Some questions are all about WORDS – in this example you are given Blue to colour and then the word sock to....

The answer is clothing – Blue is a colour and socks are clothing

[5 \rightarrow 13] [11 \rightarrow 19] [6 \rightarrow ?] A 9 B 12 C 14 D 16 E 18

Some questions are all about NUMBERS In this example you are given: 5 - 13, 11 - 19


So what does 6 go to out of the choices?

Can you see a pattern in 5 - 13 and 11 - 19 which you can apply and pick a number from the choices.

The answer is C- 14.


This is because the gap between 5 and 13 is 8 and the gap between 11 and 19 is also 8.

If we add 8 to 6 we get 14 (answer C)




Some questions are all about shapes and patterns – in this example you are given 3 shapes and you have to find the shape which matches out of the choices given.

In this question the answer is A. This is because the first 3 shapes all have 5 sides, as does A.



Some questions are all about shapes and patterns – in this example you are given 2 shapes at the top. Can you see what has changed between these 2 shapes.


So if we do the same to the next shape what is the answer?




In this question which of the shapes above the shape contain the same shape in it!

The answer is D as it has the triangle hidden within it.

You will be given an individual number and code by the teacher who takes you to the ICT room. When you get to the webpage type it in.



Once you have logged in you will start a test by clicking on the one which is unlocked. You will work through the 3 tests in 3 different lessons.
