<p>Reading: Students will complete an end of unit reading assessment with questions of varying levels of complexity. (Formative)</p> <p>Translation and grammar: These skills will be assessed informally through weekly ‘Grammar Guru’ tasks. Scores will be taken in as with vocabulary tests. (Formative)</p> <p>Speaking – discussion: Students will complete a speaking assessment to assess their ability to apply key grammar and vocabulary in an exam-style situation.
