Developing	I can understand main points and opinions from longer passages. I can recognise when people are talking about what they'd like to do in future.	I can produce short paragraphs giving information and some opinions. I can give some information using regular past tense verbs with very little support.	I can use <i>on peut</i> and opinion verbs with infinitive verbs. I can use the perfect tense of regular –er verbs confidently with <i>j'ai, tu as, il a, elle a, on a</i> . I can also use them correctly with a negative (<i>ne...pas</i>). I can use <i>je voudrais</i> to say what I would like for the future. I can make basic comparisons.	I regularly score 6-7/10 on vocab tests.
Secure	I can understand main points, opinions and some details in long passages.	I can produce paragraphs giving a range of information, expressing opinions and adding detail. I can give information in the past tense using regular verbs with no support. I can describe hopes for the future with some support.	I can use a verb table to use <i>pouvoir</i> with other pronouns. I can confidently use more complex opinion phrases with infinitive verbs, with a range of pronouns. I am confident in constructing sentences in the perfect tense with regular –er verbs, using all pronouns and in the negative form. I can use a selection of set conditional tense phrases to say what I hope for the future. I can use a range of comparison phrases.	I regularly score 8-9/10 on vocab tests.
Excellence	I can understand more complex opinions and different tenses in long paragraphs.	I can use a range of tenses to describe events in the past and hopes for the future with little to no support. I can bring in ideas and vocab from other topics.	I am confident in constructing opinion phrases (<i>adorer, aimer, n'aimer pas, détester</i>) with infinitives, with all pronouns and in negative form. I can accurately use a range of verbs in the conditional tense to express hopes for the future. I can make comparisons with lots of different adjectives, including exceptions to the rule, eg. <i>mieux instead of plus bon</i> .	I regularly score 10/10 on vocab tests.
