Our Student Achievement



At The Latimer Arts College, we believe in encouraging students to aspire for the highest possible academic achievement. We believe in the value of examinations as the 'passport' for accessing higher education or training and a wider choice of careers. We have a track record over recent years of strong, above national performance.

GCSE and Level 2 Performance Measures

Schools are now judged on the main following measures:

Student Progress (Progress 8): the average progress made by students in 8 subjects, with Maths and English progress having a double weighting. This is reported as a number which compares the progress made by students at the school, to the national progress made by similar students. A score above 0 means students at the school are making better progress than the national average. This is a comparison which shows you how much progress all students or all abilities make at a school or college.

Student Attainment (Attainment 8): the best grades students achieve in 8 subjects. This is reported as a number, which adds the scores of the best 8 grades achieved by each student. This is compared to the score achieved by all students nationally, and takes **no account** of their starting points from Key Stage 2.

GCSE and Level 2 Performance

In 2021 examinations were replaced by Centre Assessed Grades. The results achieved by our students were in line with our previous set of results, meaning that students would have achieved above national progress for these subjects.

Because of the difficulties with examinations in both 2020 and 2021 we also include our most recent examination results. In both 2018 and 2019 students at The Latimer Arts College made above expected progress, with our results putting us in the top 30% of schools.

In 2019 the Progress score for students was +0.24 and the attainment 8 score for students was 50.4 points. These are both above the national average and local average.
